

Township of Mantua
Reorganization Meeting
January 2, 2018
Mantua Township Municipal Building
5:00 P.M.

On the above date at 5:00 p.m. the 2018 Reorganization Meeting was held in the Mantua Township Municipal Building, 401 Main Street, Mantua, New Jersey 08051.

Township Deputy Clerk Pamela LeVine welcomed everyone and wished all a Happy New Year.

Mrs. LeVine called the meeting to order and asked for everyone to rise for the flag salute and remain standing for the Invocation offered by Pastor Doug Baitinger, Mantua United Methodist Church, Boy Scout Troop 83 presented the Colors and led the Flag Salute.

Mrs. LeVine then read the Statement of the Presiding Officer: "Notice of this Reorganization Meeting was given in compliance with the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act, more than 48 hours in advance by providing a Notice of Reorganization Meeting to the South Jersey Times and Courier-Post newspapers, for publication in their public meeting notice columns. Notice was also posted more than 48 hours in advance on the bulletin board in the Mantua Township Municipal Building."

Mrs. LeVine performed a roll call. Present were Committeeman Scirrotto, Committeeman Zimmerman, Committeewoman Lukens, Mrs. Jennica Bileci, Township Administrator, and Mr. Jeffrey Daniels, Esq.

Mrs. LeVine stated that on November 7, 2017, the General Election was held and the certified results found the victors to be Mr. John Legge received 2,677 votes and Mr. Layton received 3,226 votes. Mr. Legge will serve a t here year term and Mr. Layton will fill the unexpired term until December 31, 2018 on the Township Committee commencing today upon being sworn in.

Joined by his family, Mr. Legge was sworn in by the Honorable Superior Court Judge Timothy Chell. Judge Chell noted that it is an honor to swear in Mr. Legge as they have known each other for many years.

Joined by his family, Mr. Layton's was sworn in by the Honorable Stephen Sweeney, New Jersey Senate President.

At this time Mrs. LeVine opened the nominations for Mayor of the Township of Mantua for 2018. All were in favor. Committeeman Zimmerman made a motion to nominate Pete Scirrotto for Mayor of the Township of Mantua for 2018, seconded by Committeeman Legge. Mrs. LeVine asked if there were any other nominations. As there were no other nominations, Mrs. LeVine asked for motion to close the nominations. Committeeman Zimmerman made a motion to close the nominations, seconded by Committeeman Legge. All were in favor.

Mrs. LeVine stated a nomination has been made and seconded for Pete Scirrotto for Mayor of the Township of Mantua for the year 2018. Mrs. LeVine presented to the Township Committee Resolution R-1-2018, appointing Pete Scirrotto as Mayor of the

Township of Mantua for the year 2018. Committeeman Zimmerman made a motion to approve Resolution R-1-20187, seconded by Committeeman Legge. All were in favor.

Mrs. LeVine announced the motion was adopted. The Oath of Office for Mayor Scirrotto was administered by The Hon. Stephen M. Sweeney, New Jersey Senate President.

Mayor Scirrotto opened the nominations for Deputy Mayor of the Township of Mantua for 2018. The motion was made by Committeeman Legge, seconded by Committeewoman Lukens. All were in favor. Committeeman Legge nominated Robert Zimmerman for Deputy Mayor, seconded by Committeewoman Lukens. All were in favor.

As no other nominations were brought forth, Mayor Scirrotto asked for a motion to close the nominations, which was made by Committeeman Legge, seconded by Committeewoman Legge. All were in favor.

Mayor Scirrotto presented to the Township Committee Resolution R-2-2018, appointing Robert Zimmerman as Deputy Mayor. Committeeman Legge made a motion to approve Resolution R-2-2018, seconded by Committeewoman Lukens. All were in favor.

Deputy Mayor Zimmerman was administered the Oath of Office by the Honorable Superior Court Judge Silvanio. Judge Silvanio noted that it is an honor to swear Bob in as he too once sat on the Committee here and it's a great group of people and it was his honor.

Mayor Scirrotto called for a Roll Call vote to follow the consented agenda items listed as Resolution R-3-2018 to Resolution R-36-2018. Deputy Mayor Zimmerman made a motion to approve Resolutions R-3-2018 through R-36, 2018, seconded by Committeeman Legge. All were in favor.
